Phase I for English Language Arts includes (1) Overview & instructional shifts; (2) Appendices, explanations & examples; (3) New levels of learning: rigor & cognitive demand; (4) Deconstructing the standards; (5) Assessments & content frameworks.

Phase I training builds awareness of the AZ Common Core Standards, with participants able to describe the architecture of the standards & grade level documents, apply new expectations for rigor & cognitive demand, & unwrap standards to plan & implement instruction.

Phase 2 does not consist of a single course per content area; instead, it concerns all classes that help us implement the core standards. ⇒ ELA Reading Foundations: Move on When Reading (K-3)

This course is recommended for K-3 teachers, K-12 special education teachers, literacy specialists, & coaches. It is strongly aligned to AZ Common Core Standards (ELA Foundational Skills for K-5, Reading Standards for Literature & Informational Text for K-5, & Language Standards for K-5). The content includes current research & evidence based practices that are necessary for the development of the technical skills of reading along with academic vocabulary & deep comprehension. Important components of an effective comprehensive reading program designed to develop proficient readers, competent writers & critical thinkers are included in this material.

⇒ Social Studies & the Common Core for 4-12 Teachers
